

Q1 What is your highest academic qualification?








Q3 When did you last take part as a learner in a training activity related to your work (either online or classroom-based)?

Q4 What is your employment status? Please select all that apply.




Q5 How many years have you worked as a technical communicator?




Q7 How many technical communicators do you typically work with?





The chart on the next page shows the percentage of respondents who listed a particular application. Version numbers were ignored in collating the lists.

If you read the chart clockwise, starting with Microsoft Word, and the legend horizontally (again, starting with Microsoft Word) the key is easier to follow.

All applications selected by only one person have been included in 'Other' (78 people, or 44.83% of the respondents specified an application not specified by anyone else).








Q18 For employees only: Have you had a pay rise in the last 12 months?

Q19 Where did you hear of this survey?












Q22 Are you a member of the ISTC, and if so, what is your membership grade?






